

ADVICE ON THE COLOUR TAUPE

Taupe is a neutral hue, and describes a range of colours, as per Pantone shades below.



- The complement of taupe is blue, split-complement colours are purple and blue.
- Taupe pairs best with colours that keep it from looking bland and is excellent for offsetting brighter colours.
- The name comes from the French for mole, referring to 'moleskin'.
- Taupe is seen as timeless, neutral, practical, basic, authentic, organic, and modest.
- The versatility of this colour is due to its timelessness, taupe will never go out of style.
- People who favour taupe are dependable, classic, and down to earth.
- These individuals tend to be modest and fit in with just about anyone and their warmth makes others gravitate toward them.
