Peat-free growing media requires greater levels of attention to detail relative to peat-based potting mixes. Crop losses and crop uniformity issues in the first couple of weeks post-potting can be significant due to the various factors which influence plant establishment, especially with plug plants from small cell sizes.

This workshop covers the key factors and their impact on crop establishment, important peat-free growing media characteristics, handling of young plant material, potting depths and impact of mulches, rooting stimulants, as well as irrigation and nutrient management in the early crop establishment stage.
