#### **Nursery detail**

The focus of this three-day study tour to Denmark is on field- and container-grown production of hardy ornamentals, roses, hedging, and forestry subjects. A mix of various sized nurseries have been selected with an emphasis on both production and plant breeding on the islands of Zealand and Funen, and the Jutland peninsula.

#### Poulsen Roses, Fredensborg

Established in 1878, the business has become one of the world's leading rose breeders. Starting as a traditional family run business with many well-known varieties of miniature roses, the business portfolio now includes climbing, pot, and cut flower roses, with over 200 licenced varieties. In 1994, the business also ventured into breeding clematis. Poulsen roses are sold in more than 60 countries and more than 40% of all pot roses sold worldwide are Poulsen roses.

#### **Buddes Plantskole, Bogense**

A well respected, family run, 50-hectare sized nursery specialising in the traditional production of both field- and container-grown roses, and various hedging species for the retail sector. A wide range of rose varieties will be available to view.

#### Nemhaek, Fredericia

Nemhaek are specialist growers of instant hedging using a novel 'Nemhaek elements' cultivation system where plants of fagus and ligustrum are grown in 100 cm 'slabs', three plants per slab. The groundbreaking cultivation system optimises root development both before and after planting, ensuring rapid establishment.

#### Johansens Planteskole, Børkop

Johansen's Nursery was founded in 1937 as a small, local nursery. Today, the company is one of the country's leading nurseries, which, in addition to sales in Denmark, has significant exports to several European countries. The business is heavily involved in Christmas tree production as well as field-grown hedging, forestry, and ornamental crops.

#### **Gunnar Christensens Planteskole, Fjenneslev**

A traditional container-grown ornamentals business with a wide range of nursery stock, herbaceous perennials, strawberries, cane and bush fruit, and herbs. The nursery produces 1.5 million ornamental and fruit plants on 25 hectares of various outdoor beds, tunnels, shading structures, and glasshouses.


#### **Dragør Havn**

The port of Dragør has been the hub of countless maritime activities since the Middle Ages: herring fishing, shipping, privateering, piloting and the salvage of grounded ships – it used to be one of Denmark's largest shipping towns. With its narrow streets and low houses from the 18th and 19th centuries, the town centre is one of the best-preserved cities in Denmark.

Room and breakfast prices - standard double for one person, per night DKK 1.125,00 (approximately £128), standard double for two people, per night DKK 1.325,00 (approximately £151). HTA will collect all the booking information and communicate with the hotel the expected numbers and detail, delegates are then required to pay for the rooms on arrival at the hotel. Late cancellations (30 days or less) will incur charges. The hotel is within walking distance of the city centre and close to the historical area (near 4. museum on the map below). Further reminders concerning room booking will be circulated to delegates.



#### Important study tour detail

HTA have funded the development of this study tour by Zest Sustainable ICM and will cover the coach costs during onward travel within Denmark. Flight, hotel, meal, and refreshment costs need to be covered by delegates. A passport with at least three months validity from the date of travel will be required, travel insurance is recommended, along with a means of payment while in Denmark (a mixture of card and Danish Krone is suggested). It is the responsibility of delegates to book appropriate flight times to enable group departure from Copenhagen airport by 13:00 on the 8 July, and to allow sufficient time between arriving back at Copenhagen airport and departure on the 10 July (flight times are provided). The study tour will be limited to 20 delegates, a maximum of two per business.
