An understanding of the climate within protected structures, and the micro-climate around crops, is key to the effective management of crop quality, growth, and disease development. Such an understanding is a pre-requisite of getting the most from any climate control system in place.

This workshop covers the key environmental parameters and their impact on crop production, the types of heating systems and their influence on energy costs, novel approaches for securing sustainable energy sources, climate management and crop monitoring techniques in protected structures, and the use of materials, such spectral filter plastics, to manipulate the environment.
