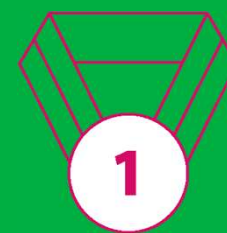
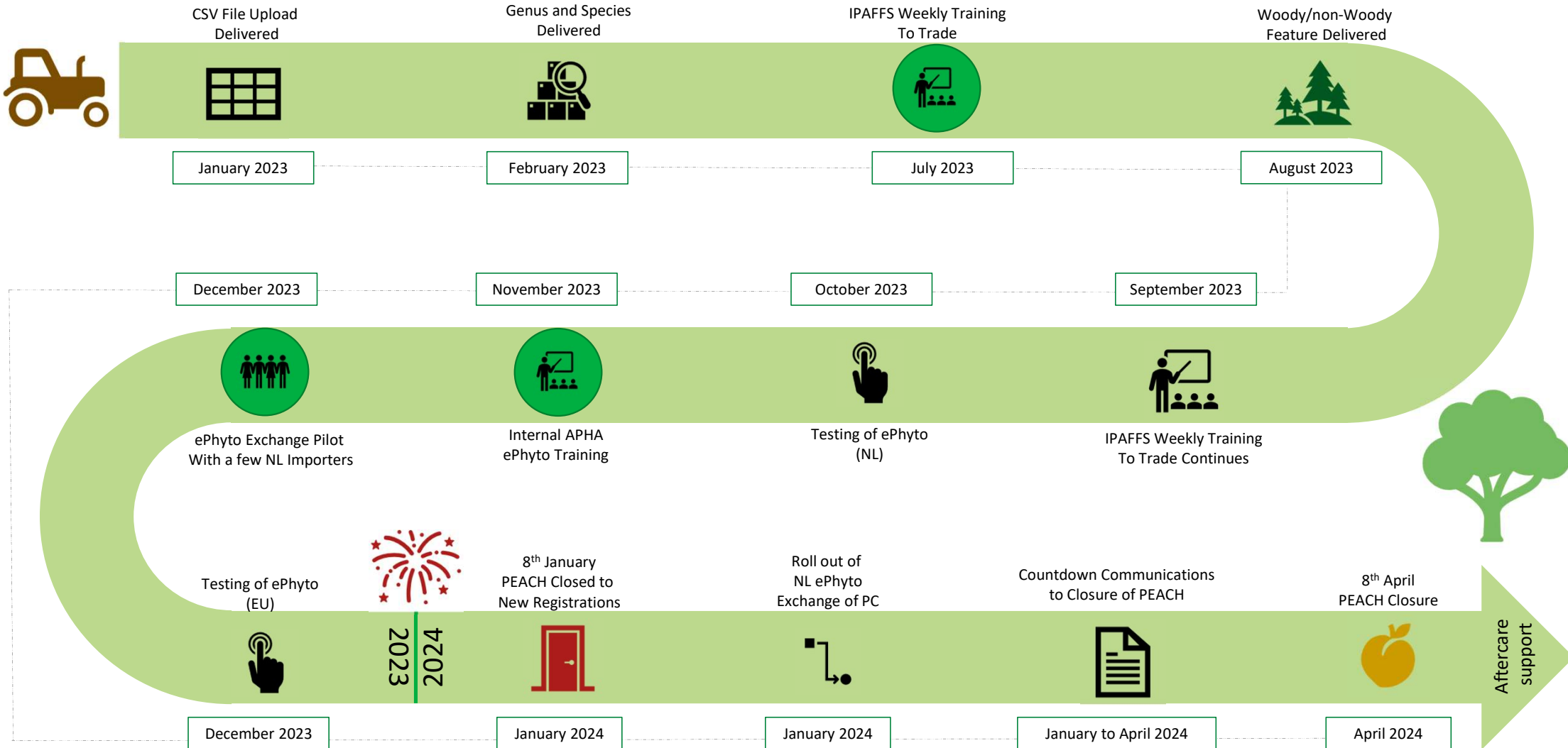

PEACH to IPAFFS Transition – How far we have come & where are we headed



PEACH to IPAFFS Transition – Legislation Timeline

January – March 2024

Legislation :

Import notifications

31st January 2024

- Introduce phytosanitary certificates (PCs) for medium risk plants and plant products for goods exported from the EU.
- Begin sample documentary checks on medium risk goods from the EU, but there will be no new routine controls undertaken on these goods at the border, so initially there will be no charges for documentary checks or holds for inspection.
- The removal of pre notification requirements for low-risk plant and plant products from the EU. (17 Nov 23)
- Introduce pre-notification requirements for Irish plants non plant products goods that enter Great Britain via West Coast ports.

Closure of PEACH to New Registrations
8th January 2024

April – June 2024

Legislation :

Introduction of BCPs/CPs

Switch off PODs

30th April 2024

- The new checks at the border on medium risk EU origin goods will be introduced
- (except at West Coast GB ports).
- All goods to which import health controls apply will be required to enter via a point of entry that has the relevant Border Control Post or in the case of plants or plant products a Control Point designation for those goods.

PEACH to IPAFFS Transition – PEACH Closure

Green – Log into PEACH – registered users

Red – New registrations

Blue – Already registered but required to enrol

1. First step is to remove the **RED** link to restrict new traders from registering to PEACH
2. Remove the **BLUE** link to allow for any Traders who had registered to complete PEACH enrolment
3. The **GREEN** allows any traders/agents the ability to submit applications.
4. The **GREEN** link will be removed on the 8th April 2024

- To close the **red** link off to new registrations on the **8th January 2024**, allowing new users the access to PEACH during the spike of pre-Christmas notifications. Current registered Traders will continue to have access to PEACH post this closing date.
- To close off the **green** link on the **8th April 2024**, restricting trade from logging into PEACH and processing required pre-notifications.

PEACH to IPAFFS Transition – PEACH Closure Communications/Training Sessions

PEACH, the legacy IT system where traders can submit pre-notifications for their plants and plant products, will be closing down, and all pre-notifications must be made on the new IT system IPAFFS. There are two key dates that impact traders during this transition:

From Monday 8 January 2024, traders will **no longer be able to register** for the PEACH IT system. Therefore, if you need to pre-notify your plants or plant products, you should register for the IPAFFS import system [via this link](#).

As of Monday 8 April 2024, current users of the PEACH system **will no longer be able to log onto PEACH**, therefore it will not be possible to submit import pre-notifications using this system. [Please register for the IPAFFS system](#) ahead of this date to create your import notifications.

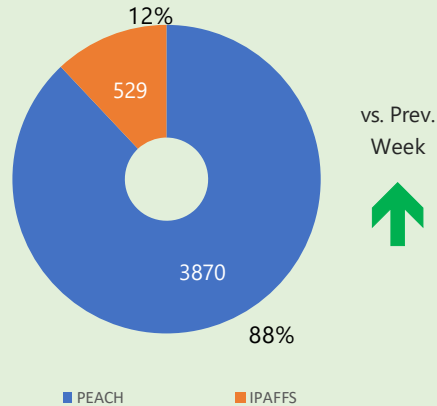

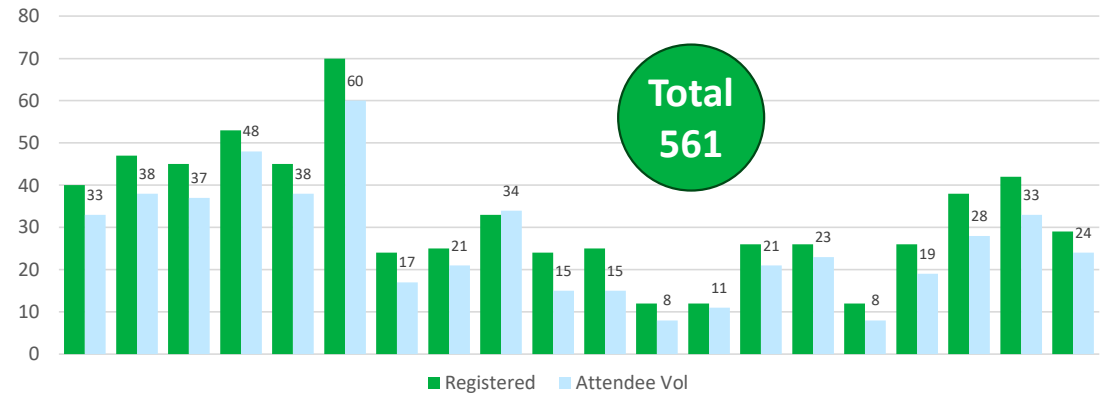

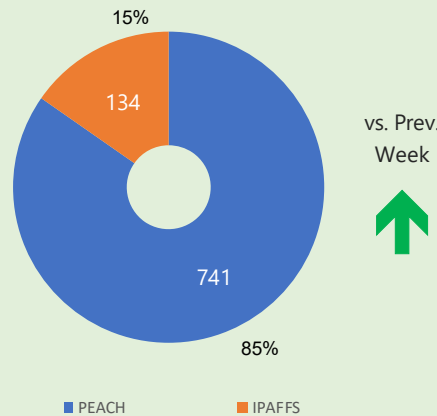
